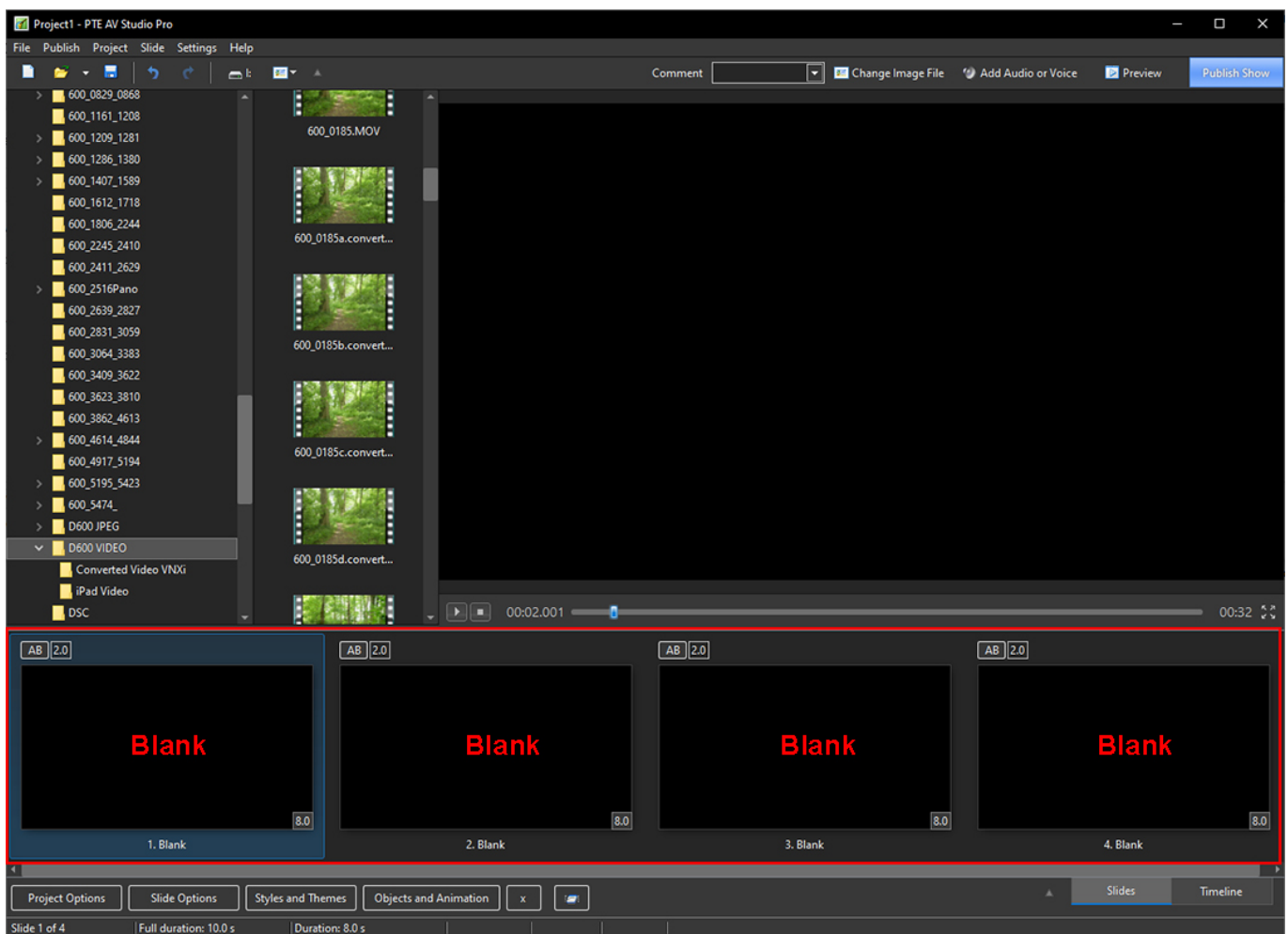


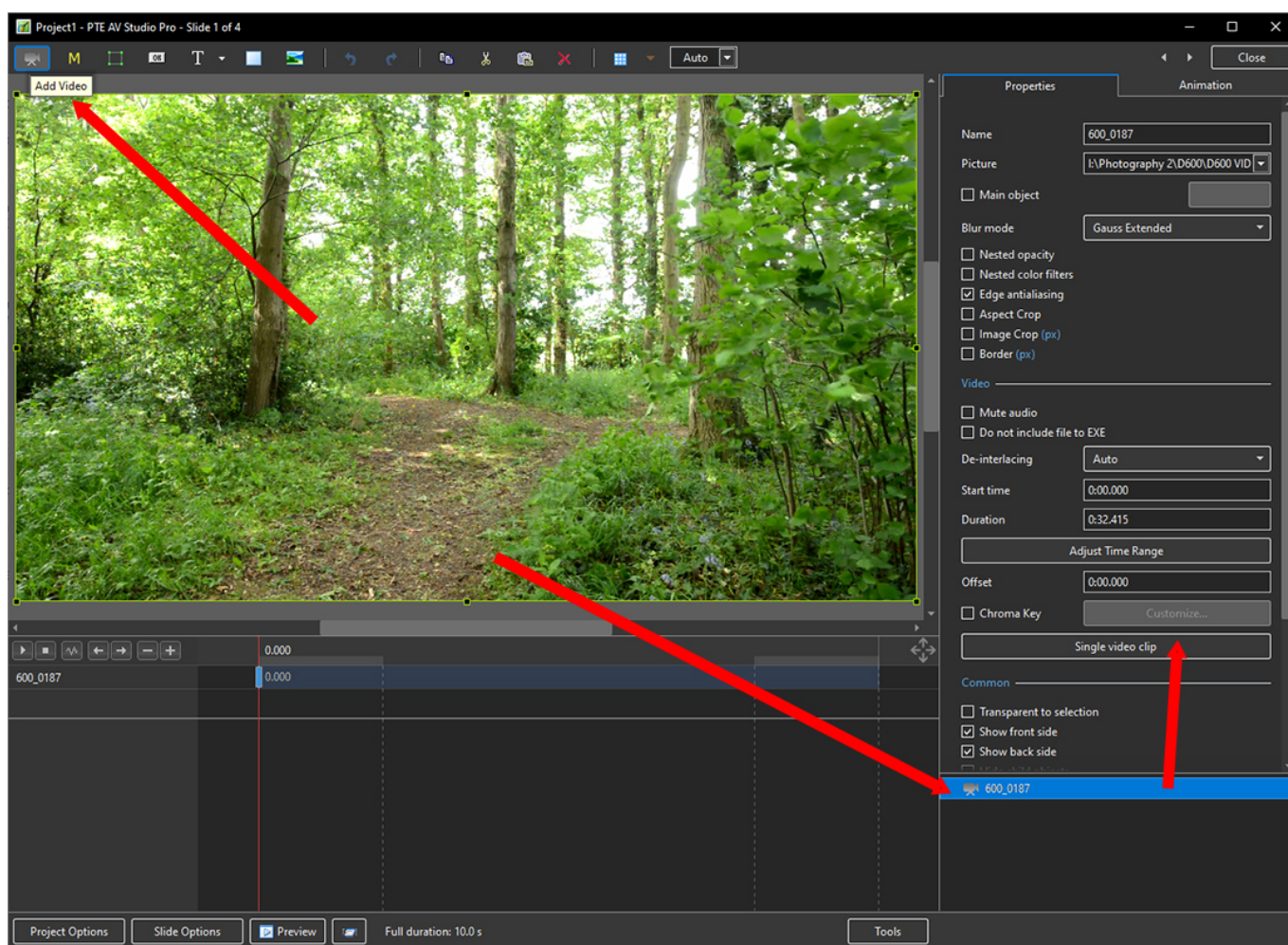
Master / Link Video

Run a video clip over multiple slides

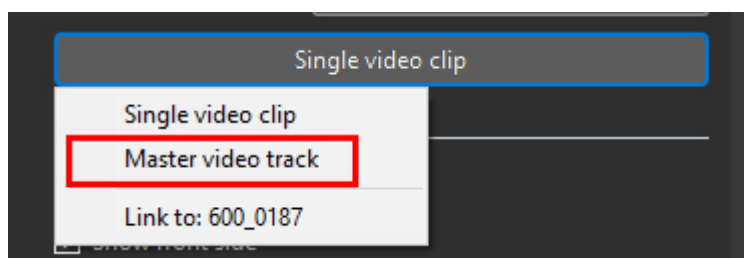
- Example:
- To run a 32 second video clip continuously over four 8 second slides
- Add four 8 second blank slides to a project (“Show Full Slide Duration” OFF in Preferences/Project)



- Open Slide 1 in the **Objects and Animation Editor** and add the 32 second video



- Change “Single Video Clip” to “Master Video Track”
